Stories of real risks while riding an All-Terrain Vehicle



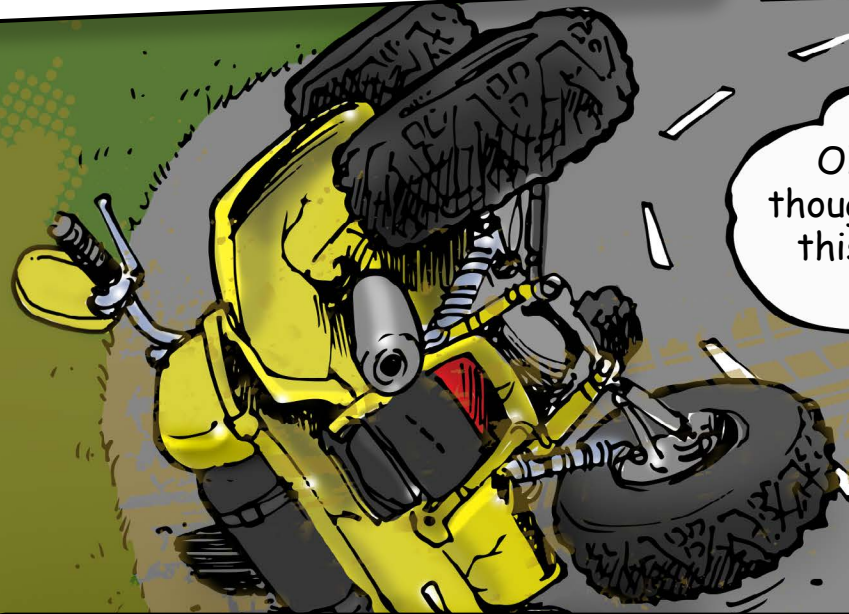
After riding on the dirt trail, he made a risky move.



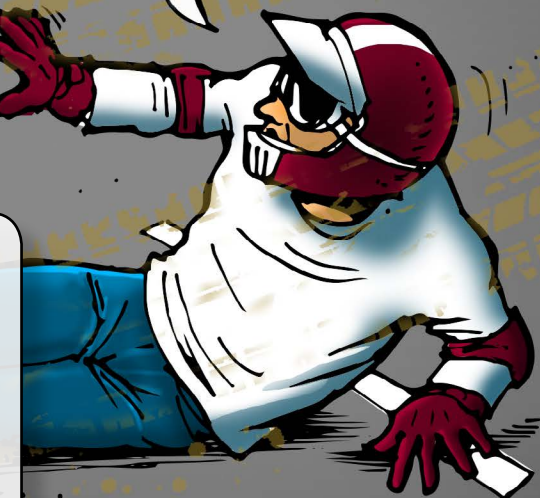
Jim was out on the trail on his new ATV. He was excited to get it out after a long week at school. He opened up the throttle to see what it could do.
